### **GLOBAL PARTNERS UNITE AND TURN DESPAIR TO HOPE**

Despair was turned to hope for 15 Dominican children and their families as a result of the partnership between global partners with one common goal - to save the lives of as many children suffering from heart disease as possible. Nine children received the gift of life through open-heart surgery, while six children received lifesaving interventional catheterization procedures to correct their heart ailments.

The expert medical team from Albany Medical Center in New York, led by pediatric cardiologist Dr. Harm Velvis was joined by pediatric cardiac surgeon, Dr. Francisco Gamero from El Salvador and perfusionist, Gustavo Carrillo from Mexico. This international team of medical professionals worked side by side with the Dominican pediatric cardiac team from Hospital Infantil Regional Universitario Dr. Arturo Gullon in Santiago, Dominican Republic to share their knowledge, enhance their skills and empower them to care for the children in their own country who suffer from heart disease.

The mission was made possible through the funding of a Rotary Global Grant which was partnered by the Rotary Club of Rotterdam Sunrise in New York and Club Rotario Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic. Additional financial support for the purchase of supplies and medicines was provided by incountry partners Fundacion Corazones del Cibao and Hospital Infantil Regional Universitario Dr. Arturo Gullon. 
